The **Vancouver Summer Program (VSP)** is a four week academic program offered by various Faculties at the University of British Columbia, Canada for cohorts of students from cooperating universities

VSP Course Packages

- Accommodation on campus
- Easy access to classrooms, recreation and campus amenities
- Free Wifi in lobby; wired high speed Internet in guest rooms
- Laundry on site



VSP Accommodation

Shared apartments (6 bedrooms)

- Private bedrooms with single bed
- In-suite bathroom
- Shared living space with TV
- Equipped kitchen



Students may also choose dormitory style accommodation which will not have cooking facilities

VSP Program Fee

The packaged fee per student is \$4500 CAD for the July 16 – August 16, 2016 program and it includes:

- Medical insurance
 - Group airport transfer and city tour
 - Shared accommodation for 31 nights
 - Orientation and farewell events
 - Course materials
 - Social activities
- (optional trips may require an additional fee)
