

2013 ELDORADO AWARD APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS TURKEY - CHINA - GREECE - BRAZIL - ROMANIA

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Eldorado Gold Corporation is a Canadian international gold producer with seven operating mines, two mines under construction, four development projects, an expansion project and an extensive exploration program. The majority of Eldorado's operating mines are in Turkey, China and Greece.

The Eldorado Scholarship program will sponsor selected students from its operating regions for one year of the Master of Engineering (M.Eng) program with the Norman B. Keevil Institute of Mining Engineering at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, Canada. An eight-month paid internship program with Eldorado will follow upon completion of year one of the Master's program at UBC. This sponsorship includes full tuition, relocation and living expenses, and is renewable for year two of the Master's program. The award recipients must maintain an excellent academic standing throughout the M.Eng program, and conduct a work term presentation at the end of internship placement to secure funding for year two.

This scholarship is available for students who are in their last year of, or graduated from an accredited undergraduate program in mining or metallurgical engineering. Strong preference is given to students that demonstrate academic merit, a positive attitude and an aspiration to pursue a career in an operational environment in their home country upon completion of the UBC Master's program.

2.0 APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for this scholarship, each application must submit a full application to the UBC Masters of Engineering Program. The application must be supplemented with a resume, cover letter and an industry-related two-page essay. The topic of the essay will be determined each year by Eldorado or UBC. UBC will shortlist and interview a selection of strong candidates, from which a final list of candidates will be recommended to Eldorado.

The Essay topic for 2013 candidates will be determined by the UBC M.Eng Program.
