

## Undergraduate International Non-Degree Guest Program Application

### Admission Requirements:

These requirements apply only to students from overseas post secondary schools. Students are not eligible to pursue a degree with international non-degree guest student admission. Students who are interested in applying in degree programs should consult the Office of Admissions and Orientation (room 1145 in the University Center.)

All application materials should be mailed to the International Office, The University of Michigan-Dearborn, 4901 Evergreen Road, Dearborn, MI 48128-2406, Attention: Emily Wang

#### **Required Materials:**

- One recommendation letter from the student's current institution or a sponsored organization recommending the student for studying at the University of Michigan - Dearborn
- ✓ Completed application form with application fee of US\$75.00
- ✓ Official Transcript from the current institution
- ✓ One of the following English Equivalency Exams:
  - TOEFL Score of 550 on paper-based examination; 213 on computer-based examination; 80 on Internet Based
  - IELTS Score of 6
  - MELAB Score of 80
- If a student has or is planning to obtain an F or J student visa, the student must submit financial certification indicating that he/she (or his/her sponsor) has sufficient funds to support the student's education at UM-Dearborn. Estimated fall 2009 expenses are as follow in the U.S. dollars:

Tuition and Fees = \$9000 Living expenses = \$5000 Books, Supplies and Mandatory Insurance = \$2000 Total of US\$16,000 for one semester (four months)

The student must:

- 1. Submit an original bank certification (in English) or from his/her financial supporter, converted to U.S. dollars
- 2. If the financial certification is from the student's financial supporter, submit a certified letter (in English) from the student's financial supporter stating that the funds indicated on the financial certification will be used to support the student's fees, and living expenses while attending UM-Dearborn. The letter has to show the original signature of the financial supporter.

Financial aid is not available to international students. Students must demonstrate full financial support before an UM-Dearborn I-20/DS-2019 form can be issued for international students.

Both F and J visa students are required to have valid health insurance while studying at UM-Dearborn. Please read information on the web site: www.umd.umich.edu/css\_health\_int\_req\_enroll
